Presentation by Rafael Vazquez -Touchline Supervisor from 211 Broward. 211 Broward is a 24 hour information and referral service for Social and Human Services, Crisis Intervention, and basically facilitating help to any one with social service needs by simply dialing 211. When you dial 211 a counselor will answer the phone and direct you to the correct agency that fits your specific needs instead of just giving a bunch of different resources that may not even pertain to the persons situation. 211 Broward is also the main suicide hot-line in Broward County and they have also expanded their mental health programs across the board for teenagers, adolescents, young adults, and seniors. They have a text to talk program available which is great for young people who feel alone and they also have the Senior touchline Program which is a free service for people age 55+ who live alone and just need someone to talk to from time to time. The touchline program is a free phone call to break the pattern of isolation. It is a quick call over the phone with a human interaction voice so that seniors don't feel alone. 211 is an excellent resource for all of Broward County.
