The City uses the high speed CodeRED notification system to alert residents in the event of a boil water order, storm, or other emergency. The only way to be sure you're in our phone number database – especially if you've traded your land line for a cell phone – is to register. It's simple to do online, and takes only minutes. ## DO YOU NEED HELP WITH THE COST OF FENCE REPAIRS?

### Residential Fence Repair Incentive Program

The Sunrise City Commission has allocated federal funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to implement a **Residential Fence Repair Incentive Program**.

This Program is intended to provide homeowners with a **financial reimbursement incentive of up to \$500** for fence repairs made to their homesteaded residential property in Sunrise.

### Eligible fence repairs may include the following:

- Replacement of fence slats, posts, and other parts of the fence
- Painting or staining an existing fence
- Installation/replacement of fence hardware

*Homeowners may make the repairs themselves and get reimbursed for the necessary materials, up to \$500. If the homeowner chooses to hire a contractor to perform the work, up to \$500 in contractor fees would be eligible for reimbursement.*

Please note that any fence repair valued at greater than \$1,500 requires a permit from the Building Division of the Community Development Department. Permit costs are not eligible for reimbursement. Work performed by a Homeowners Association or within common areas is not eligible for the Program.

### In order to qualify for this Program, an applicant must:

- Own a homesteaded residential property in the City of Sunrise;
- Purchase eligible repair items (or hire a contractor for fence repairs) after June 1, 2023, and ensure that the repairs are completed prior to application submission.

All fence repairs shall conform to the City Code of Ordinances and the Florida Building Code.
