Resisting Without Violence, Fleeing & Eluding, Felony Probation Violation, & Driving with a Suspended Driver's License

Location: Walmart, 3306 N University Drive, City of Sunrise, Broward County, State of Florida

On the aforementioned date and at the specified location, I, Officer J. Hennessy, a member of the Sunrise Police Department, responded to a report of a theft in progress at Walmart. Upon arriving at the scene, I engaged with store employees positioned at the grocery entrance and requested information regarding the whereabouts of the store's Loss Prevention (LP) personnel.

A female store associate contacted LP and relayed information that the suspect was located at the back of the store near the Online Pickup area. Subsequently, I proceeded toward the rear of the store and observed LP Officer Lucien Joseph discreetly monitoring the suspect. The suspect, was a black male, was wearing a black and red baseball cap, a black hoodie, green camouflage pants, and bright red sneakers. He was pushing a shopping cart loaded with merchandise toward the store exit.

LP Officer Joseph discreetly indicated the suspect to me and confirmed his identity multiple times. The suspect, realizing he was being observed, abandoned the shopping cart and attempted to evade surveillance by cutting through the clothing department on his way to the front exit.

I swiftly approached the suspect and, wearing my official Sunrise Police Department Class B uniform, featuring city and department insignia, ordered him to stop. At this juncture, the suspect had passed all payment points, and it was uncertain if he was concealing additional stolen items on his person. To minimize the appearance of a criminal investigation, I informed the suspect that he was to be issued a trespass notice from the store.

I requested the suspect's identification, to which he responded, "I don't got no identification, that's bullshit." I informed the suspect that he was detained and not at free to leave.

Shortly thereafter, the suspect began walking away from me toward the store exit, ignoring my commands. I moved to intercept him, at which point he swiftly attempted to evade my grasp and proceeded to flee. I promptly seized the suspect and ordered him to stop, yet he refused to comply with my lawful commands. Instead, he actively resisted my efforts to detain him by pushing and pulling away.

The suspect wrested himself free from my grip by removing his black hoodie and subsequently ran out through the grocery exit of the store. At this juncture, I drew my department-issued taser, audibly announced, "Taser, taser, taser," and deployed one cartridge (two probes) into the suspect's back. I then deployed a second cartridge in the effort to incapacitate the suspect, appearing to strike him in the right arm. As he exited the store and entered the parking lot, the suspect began to fall. I instructed the suspect to "get down on the ground, stay down," but he quickly regained his footing and fled north through the parking lot. My attempts to reactivate the probes proved ineffective.

The suspect proceeded to run east along the north side of the building, circling back toward the store. He then sprinted toward a red Chevrolet Equinox with Florida license plate #QXPA29. The suspect entered the driver's seat and immediately drove northbound within the shopping center. Simultaneously, additional officers arrived on the scene and endeavored to stop the suspect, using their marked patrol vehicles with lights and sirens active. The suspect, however, refused to stop for these officers (see supplements for further details).

Returning to the store entrance, I retrieved the suspect's discarded black hoodie and baseball cap. I subsequently met with LP Officer Joseph to review the store's video surveillance footage. I provided LP Joseph with an evidence.com link to upload the video footage of the incident. Additionally, LP Joseph furnished a receipt indicating the merchandise in the shopping cart, which amounted to \$1,263.48. It remains unknown whether the suspect had additional stolen items on his person at the time of attempted apprehension.

After reviewing my body-worn camera footage, a clear image of the suspect's face was captured. Through police databases, officers successfully identified the suspect as Terrence Antonio Harvey (Date of Birth: 08/02/85), Florida Driver's License H-610-801-85-282-0. After reviewing on-file photographs of the suspect, I confirmed the suspect's identity as that of the individual who I had just had personal interaction with and who had just fled from me.

Further database searches disclosed that the suspect possessed a suspended Florida driver's license and was currently on probation for Aggravated Battery against a Law Enforcement Officer, Firefighter, Emergency Medical Services Provider, or similar personnel, with the probation term ending on 02/19/2048. Consequently, the suspect was charged with resisting arrest without violence, fleeing and eluding, and felony violation of probation. An out-of-custody probable cause affidavit was duly prepared.

I completed a Response to Resistance report and a Conducted Electrical Weapon use form. The probable cause affidavit was left in records. A criminal citation for fleeing and eluding was issued and sent via certified mail to the address listed on the suspect's driver's license. The black hoodie, red and black baseball cap, and taser cartridges were submitted into evidence. My body-worn camera remained active throughout the duration of the incident. The scene was ultimately cleared without further incident.
