<p><u>Contact was made with Bernado Espanol reference to serving a temporary restraining order. Bernado refused to come out of the residence and speak to Sunrise Officers over the matter, only speaking to us through a bathroom window. Bernado was extremely irate over temporary protection order being served and having to leave the home. At one-point, Bernado walked away and didn't close the window all the way. As I pushed the window upwards to keep an eye on Bernado, he ran back and pushed it down. He closed the window on my fingers, pressing down and trapping my right fingers on the bottom of the window. I had to forcefully push the window back upwards in an attempt to free my fingers. I could feel Bernado continuing to push the window down from the other side, until I was able to overpower his attempts to crush my fingers and open the window and freeing my hand. Bernado became even more upset and started balling both his fist at me, charging back and forth at the window while screaming. Bernado turned around and as he ran back deeper into the unit, I feared given his increase agitation towards us and the fact he attempted to crush my fingers in the window, he would retrieve a possible weapon or flee from our custody. I deployed my Taser and gave him verbal commands to stop or he would get tasered. Bernado refused to comply with my verbal commands and I deployed my Taser, striking him on his right side. Bernado fell to the floor due to the Taser deployment, at which time Sunrise Officers</u></p>

Bernado suffered a laceration above his right eye and swelling around his right eye. Sunrise Rescue 72 responded to the scene and transported Bernado to Westside Regional Medical Center for medical treatment. After being medically cleared, Bernado was transported to BSO Main.

Sunrise Officers responded to 9441 Sunrise Lakes Boulevard #104 reference to serving a temporary restraining order. Upon arrival, contact was made with (VI) [REDACTED] who provided me with a sealed envelope containing a Temporary Injunction for Protection Against Domestic Violence (Case no. DVCE 23-006051) to be served against her husband, (SU) Bernado Espanol (W/M, 09/11/53).

Bernado was witnessed by me outside the apartment (unit 104), throwing items back inside the home and closing the front door upon seeing me arrive in front of the building. He witnessed me in front of the unit, and upon closing the front door, he came to the kitchen window and yelled out to asking what I wanted. I told him I did not know at the time and needed to find out. After speaking to [REDACTED] and obtaining the sealed envelope containing the Temporary Injunction for Protection Against Domestic Violence, I attempted to make contact with Bernado, who was inside the residence. Bernado refused to open the front door and could be heard screaming inside the unit. Bernado opened the bathroom window (located to the right of the front door) and advised that he wasn't going to open the door and would only speak to me through the window, screaming how [REDACTED] stole his gun and Officers were refusing to find it. I advised him I had Temporary Injunction for Protection Against Domestic Violence to serve and he needed to open the door. Again, Bernado refused to open the door and continued to speak to me and over me through the bathroom window. As I read Bernado the provisions of the Temporary Injunction for Protection Against Domestic Violence, he continued to scream obscenities at me over the matter. As I reached the page in which the court ordered the Petitioner [REDACTED] the residence, and the Respondent (Bernado Espanol) had to vacate the residence, Bernado became even more upset and closed the window. Sunrise Officers stepped back and waited for additional Officers to respond.

While waiting, I spoke to [REDACTED] who advised she wished to return to her residence and had the keys to the front door (which was locked at the time). In our initial conversation, [REDACTED] advised she left the residence around August 13th due to Bernado being physically violent towards her.

Conversation was started again with Bernado through the locked front door, who refused several lawful verbal commands from me to come outside the residence and vacate it per order of the Temporary Injunction for Protection Against Domestic Violence. Bernado again opened the bathroom window and started screaming at me, again refusing to come out and vacate the residence per the Temporary Injunction for Protection Against Domestic Violence.

Bernado became more agitated towards us and as he turned around and walked away from us, he partially closed the window. In order to keep an eye on Bernado for officer safety reasons given his increased agitation over the matter and towards us, I slid the window up to get a clear view of him and his actions. As I opened the window, Bernado ran back towards me and closed the window on my fingers, pressing down and trapping my right fingers on the bottom of the window. I had to forcefully push the window back upwards in an attempt to free my fingers. I could feel Bernado continuing to push the window down from the other side, until I was able to overpower his attempts to crush my fingers and open the window and freeing my hand.

Bernado became even more upset and started balling both his fist at me, charging back and forth at the window while screaming. Bernado turned around and as he ran back into deeper into the unit, I feared given his increase agitation towards us and the fact he attempted to crush my fingers in the window, he would retrieve a possible weapon or flee from our custody. I displayed my Taser and gave him verbal commands to stop or he would get

tasered. Bernado refused to comply with my verbal commands and I deployed my Taser, striking him on his right side (my Taser prongs impacted him on his right lower tricep area and right belt line). Bernado fell to the floor due to the Taser deployment, at which time Sunrise Officers gained access to the residence using the keys provided by [REDACTED] and detained Bernado.

It should be noted from the start of the incident, Bernado had a clear understanding that I was a Police Officer performing my duties. My marked City of Sunrise Police Department vehicle was clearly visible to him as I pulled up to the front of the building and faced his unit. Myself, and the two other Sunrise Officers were both wearing our Department issued road patrol uniforms with our badge and City insignia clearly displayed on our shoulders, as well as "POLICE" on the back of our outer vest carriers.

Sunrise Rescue 72 responded to the scene and transported Bernado to Westside Regional Medical Center due to injuries suffered from his fall (Sunrise Rescue run number 10747).

While at Westside Regional Medical Center, Bernado continued with his erratic behavior towards Sunrise Officers, even making several comments towards me about how he should have crushed my fingers in the window. It wasn't until a few hours passed that Bernado calmed down and I was able to have a normal conversation with him over the incident. In conversating with Bernado, he claimed to be [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and hadn't slept in [REDACTED] months. He further claimed that someone stole his medication, which he claimed were stolen when he was [REDACTED] in the past, and that his current doctor wasn't helping him. Bernado even commented to me that he saw me pull up to the building and feared I was there to [REDACTED] him. I explained to Bernado that even in our initial contact (through the kitchen window when he screamed out to me) I didn't know why I was there and even after finding out why I was called to the residence, I tried explaining to him through the bathroom window that I was there to serve an injunction order but he would stop to listen to what I was trying to explain to him.

I explained to Bernado that if he had calmed down, talked to us about the incident and listened to our lawful commands, things would have gone much different. I further explained to him that services and assistance could have been offered to him; Bernado commented about needing help and that he had no place to go. I provided him with Henderson Mental Health Center contact information and explained to him that they have staff that could assist him with his [REDACTED] health.

After being medically cleared, Bernado was transported to BSO Main.

Photographs of Bernado and his injuries were taken and submitted to evidence.com.

While at Westside Regional Medical Center, the "Proof of Service Form" for the injunction was completed by me and faxed to BSO via the fax number provided on the form. The original "Proof of Service Form" as well as the fax receipt and page copies of the injunction paperwork showing the custody of the residence were submitted to our Records Department to be attached to the report.

My spent Taser prongs that impacted Bernado's body were removed by the staff at Westside Regional Medical Center and collected by me. The prongs as well as my deployed Taser cartridge were submitted into evidence at our Public Safety Building, locker 16.

Under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the foregoing and that the facts stated therein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
