Marketing BPAB Activities

The City Liaison informed the Board that the Bike Bingo activity will continuously be promoted throughout the year via the City’s Marketing platforms. The City Liaison updated the Board he is coordinating with the City’s Leisure Services Department regarding Board Representation at City Events, further information will be provided when it becomes available.

Wayfinding Signs Pilot Program

The City Liaison presented two (2) concept renderings of the wayfinding sign to the Board in order to receive feedback. The Board provided their feedback regarding the wayfinding sign concept renderings after discussion. The Board then unanimously voted for option #2 to be the selected wayfinding sign concept rendering. The City Liaison noted that the Board’s feedback will be provided to the Marketing Team and an updated rendering will be presented to the Board when available. The Board recommended that the program be launched in conjunction with national bike month in 2024.
