Open Discussion: Updates/Announcements Regarding Schools

Erika Reddy (New Board Member) introduced herself and provided a brief background. Each EAB member introduced themselves and length of time on the board.

Dr. Rolle.: Sandpiper Elementary – (a) Hispanic Heritage Night (Oct 19th at 5:30 pm). (b) Upcoming activities are being planned for Halloween. (c) Dr. Rolle is waiting to hear back from Sandpiper Elementary regarding reading to the students.

Aldett F.: Village Elementary – (a) Student enrollment is steadily increasing. Enrollment is up to 610 students. (b) Village is awaiting their final approval for the Cambridge program. (c) Village is looking for community partners to sponsor incentives for the students (d) Village Elementary is also trying to increase attendance and student performance.

Gesskia M.: Sawgrass Elementary – (a) Student enrollment is up to 900. A new Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, and ASD classes will be opening. (b) Panther Academy is working with the City for a Butterfly Garden (Dr. Carrie Kasher, Sustainability Officer). (c) After-school clubs are will include robotics, football, and knitting. (d) Upcoming Events: Family Book Fair, Boo-Bingo, and Dual Language Literacy night.

Richard H.: Bair Middle – (a) Bair Middle will be renewing their Verizon Innovative Learning Schools grant.

Dr. Stewart.: Discovery Elementary – (a) Discovery Elementary will be participating in the Dental Sealant Program. Students whose parents consented to the program will be obtaining sealants to help protect and keep their teeth healthy. (b) Sunrise will be hosting a Fire Safety Assembly on Oct 10th to teach students how to stay safe when they encounter a

fire.
