On 09/28/2023, 10/19/2023 and 11/13/2023 Pinnacle at Avery Glen Apartments (3871 N. Pine Island Road) captured an unknown suspect on surveillance footage stealing mail from the cluster box during the overnight hours. During all three incidents; surveillance footage captures the unknown suspect driving into the complex in a Red Kia K5, opening the cluster mailboxes with a USPS arrow key, removing the mail and placing the mail into construction-size garbage bags, and leaving in the same vehicle. On 11/13/2023, the unknown suspect was accompanied by a second unknown suspect. During these incidents, the tag number for the vehicle was not visible. These incidents were documented under Sunrise PD Case Numbers: 42-2309-046638, 42-2310-049474, and 42-2311-053575; the unknown suspect(s) were not identified at the time.

On 11/13/2023 at approximately 11:00 pm (less than an hour before Sunrise PD case number 42-2311-053575), two suspects arrived at Preserve at Avery Lakes Apartments (8769 NW 39th Street); The two suspects matched the exact physical and clothing description in Sunrise PD case number 42-2311-053575, in addition to the same Red Kia K5; this incident was also captured on surveillance footage. The suspects entered the structure where 280 mailboxes were located as they carried empty garbage bags. One suspect begins to unlock all of the mailboxes using a USPS arrow key and they both began to fill the garbage bags with mail. Once all the mail is taken out of the mailboxes the suspect locks the cluster box with the same key. As the Red Kia K5 was leaving the apartment complex, the tag number was clearly captured on surveillance footage. This incident was reported by the leasing office on the following day (42-2311-053783) and the unknown suspects were not identified at the time.

Lieutenant Berman and Detective Duvall received information that the unknown suspect(s) were possibly returning to Sunrise in the same vehicle.

On 12/08/2023 at approximately 5:45 am, the vehicle was observed by Lieutenant Berman at Innovo Living Apartments (8798 NW 38TH Street). The suspect (later identified as Joshua Scott) was then seen unlocking the cluster mailbox with a USPS arrow key and placing large amounts of mail in a black garbage bag. Joshua immediately took flight on foot upon the sight of Lieutenant Berman and Sergeant Morlock. A foot chase ensued and both Lieutenant Berman and Sergeant Morlock apprehended Joshua shortly after.

I contacted United States Postal Inspector Anthony Lawing who me	t with me at the police department to interview
Joshua. Post Miranda, Joshua	During a search incident to
arrest, a USPS arrow key was located in Joshua's pocket.	

United States Postal Inspector Anthony Lawing stated that the suspect will be later indicted on federal charges that include possession of the postal key and mail theft/possession of stolen mail. Anthony also stated that the serial number for the USPS arrow key was reported lost in August of 2023. Anthony will be returning to Sunrise Police Department to retrieve the mail and the USPS arrow key.

A search warrant for the vehicle was authored and executed. A search of the vehicle revealed that 30 credit cards/debit cards with various names were located throughout the vehicle. In addition, several checks, gift card(s), and cell phones were located throughout the vehicle.

Joshua was charged with multiple counts of Criminal Use/Possession of Personal Identification Information, Resisting Without Violence, Wearing a mask while committing a felony, and Driving while license suspended with knowledge.

On December 10, 2023, I was notified by Lt. Gordon that there was a possible mail theft in progress at the Innovo apartment complex. I arrived at the complex and requested backup via police radio. I observed a black male, later identified as Joshua Michael Scott, in front of a large community cluster mailbox which was covered by a roof. The male then walked to his vehicle, opened the trunk, and removed an item. The male walked back to the cluster mailboxes, opened a large trash bag and began removing mail. As the male was emptying the mailboxes, he was putting the mail in the trash bag. Sergeant Morlock arrived on scene at which time we approached. I drove up, turned on my police lights and exited my vehicle. As I approached the suspect Scott, I gave a loud verbal command "put your hands up, Sunrise Police!" The suspect Scott looked at me and then began running eastbound to the rear of the apartment buildings. The suspect was eventually apprehended by Sergeant Morlock. An article search was conducted by K-9 Officer Plunske. CrimeScene responded to photograph and collect evidence. See original report for additional information.
