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



On 12/06/2023 at approximately 2:12am, Detectives were conducting a mail theft operation located specifically at 5010 Hiatus Road Sunrise, FL 33351. This operation was created because of the continuous issue of mail thefts that have occurred at this specific commercial mailbox. During this operation, multiple detectives were in unmarked police vehicles that were stationary in the business plaza where the commercial mailbox is located. On five previous dates (10/13/2023, 10/18/2023, 11/04/2023, 11/14/2023 and 11/21/2023) various subjects in various vehicles have arrived at the mailbox during the overnight hours, opened the commercial mailbox with a USPS arrow key and have taken the mail from the mailbox which is shared by 12 different businesses in the plaza. These incidents were all caught on clear surveillance footage.

At the aforementioned time, a blue vehicle (4-door, Audi A4 bearing FL Tag: AFO-2UF) entered the plaza and parked in front of the commercial mailboxes. Detective Colin Douglass witnessed an unknown passenger exit the blue vehicle, walk up to the commercial mailbox, open the mailbox with a USPS arrow key and begin to steal the mail. As the passenger was walking back to the vehicle with the stolen mail in hand; detectives attempted to detain both subjects. Upon seeing the unmarked police vehicles, affixed with blue police lights, the passenger fled on foot. The driver of the vehicle (later identified as the defendant Rashaad Hayes) remained in the vehicle, but attempted to drive off. The defendant was immediately surrounded by unmarked police vehicles. The defendant then exited the driver seat of the vehicle wearing a black balaclava that concealed his identity and he proceeded to fled on foot. As the defendant was running towards Hiatus Road, mail was falling from his person, while Detective Colin Douglass maintained constant visual. Detective Colin Douglass, identified himself as "Police," and provided loud verbal commands for the defendant to stop. The defendant ignored his commands and continued running. Detective Douglass deployed his electrical conducted device and apprehended the defendant. This incident was captured on clear surveillance footage and BWC.

A perimeter was immediately set up to search for the passenger of the vehicle who was still at large.

In plain view, the Audi A4 had mail located on the floor board of the front seat, passenger seat and backseat of the vehicle. The backseat had mail that piled up from the floor board and overflowed to the entire backseat of the vehicle.

After the defendant was apprehended near 5000 Hiatus Road, he waived his Miranda Rights and agreed to speak to Detective Colin Douglass and I (captured on BWC). Post Miranda, [REDACTED]

In plain view, a firearm was located on the driver seat floor board of the Audi A4 where the defendant was seated; the defendant stated that he purchased the firearm and admitted ownership of the firearm. A criminal history check of the defendant revealed that he is a convicted felon out of Illinois and the defendant does not possess a Florida driver's license.

Based on the above listed facts, the defendant was charged with Criminal Use/Possession of Personal Identification



A vehicle suppression tactic was utilized and the vehicle was prevented from leaving the scene.

The driver of the vehicle (later identified as Rashaad Hayes) exited the vehicle with mail in his hand and fled on foot. The suspect actively resisted law enforcement and fled on foot from Officers. After yelling "Police!" "Stop!" and "Taser!", I deployed two taser cartridges that struck the subject in the center of his back with a single probe. The suspect continued running and was ultimately apprehended after he tripped over foliage. He was detained by Detective Roberson and I.


I read Rashaad his Miranda Warnings and he agreed to speak with me. In summary, 

Rashaad advised he was not injured as a result of the tasing. Det. Burstein accompanied him to the hospital where he was treated for knee pain and taser probe contact. Rashaad was medically cleared and later transported to BSO Main Jail for processing.

A CEW and RRR were completed by this Detective and submitted to the Chief of Police via the Chain of Command in accordance with Agency Policy and Procedure.

The specific questions and statements can be obtained from the uploaded body-worn camera footage from this incident. All statements listed above are summaries of what was said during the interviews and conversations with the involved parties.
