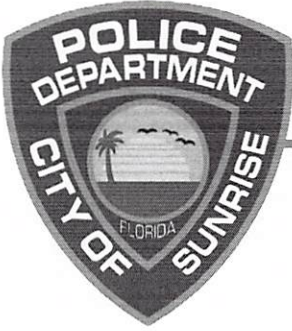

<p>I was dispatched to the Double Tree Parking Garage in reference to a subject who was trespassing and refused to leave. The caller/ witness relayed that the subject became verbally aggressive towards him when he told him to leave and that he had a boxcutter in his possession.</p>			
<p>Upon contact with the subject on the third floor of the parking garage, I observed that he was rummaging through his trunk area of his vehicle. I observed a suspicious black fanny pack type bag that had multiple baggies inside of it. A records check of the individual revealed that his driver's license was suspended and that a seize tag order was placed on his vehicle.</p>			
<p>Based on the criminal complaint, the traffic offense and the report of the subject being armed, I attempted to detain him for officer safety while I continued my investigation. Once told to turn around, the defendant became uncooperative and fled on foot as Ofc. Sunanon attempted to handcuff him. I was able to grab the subject and he braced, pulled and pushed my hands away from him to avoid being handcuffed. After a physical struggle, I was able to guide him to the ground. Despite several verbal commands and verbal warnings that I</p>

I was aware of the documented incident from monitoring radio traffic. I responded to the scene and contacted the parties listed in this report. I first made my way to the suspect who was detained in the back of a marked police car. I observed he was alert, breathing normally and appeared comfortable and at ease. He did have an abrasion on the side of his face which appeared very minor.

I then spoke with the involved Officers who confirmed that they were relatively unhurt other than minor scratches and scrapes from the cement floor of the parking garage. There was no exposure to the suspects blood or bodily fluids. I was advised that the officers were dispatched to a criminal complaint of trespassing. They were informed that authorized agents of the property have ordered the subject to leave and that he refused. Officers were also notified that the subject was acting aggressive and that he was observed by the reporting person to be armed with a box cutter.

Officers responded to the scene and located the subject in question on the third floor of the parking garage.

Officers recognized their duty to investigate the alleged crime of trespassing, protect the rights of the property owner and alleviate any danger to the other patrons of the parking garage. To safely conduct these duties, Officers correctly decided to place the subject in handcuffs to locate and secure the weapon observed by the reporter. While attempting to lawfully detain the subject to facilitate the search, the subject began resisting officers in an attempt to defeat their attempts to secure him. Officers were able to deploy an electronic control device which successfully incapacitated the subject and he was taken into custody without substantial injury to himself, the officers or bystanders.

On Tuesday, 01/16/2024, I responded to 13450 W Sunrise Blvd in reference to a trespassing call.

Before arriving on scene, officers were advised that the subject, (OF) Nikkita Matheus, was armed with a box cutter. We were advised that staff had requested him to leave and that he refused and became aggressive with them.

Upon arrival, officers contacted Matheus on the third floor of the parking garage at the location. Matheus advised that his car, a 2004 blue Mini Cooper bearing the FL tag 85AANC, gave out on him and he was working on it. Officers told Matheus that this was private property and that was committing the crime of Trespassing. An exterior inspection of the vehicle revealed a suspicious bag on the dash board. The bag appeared to have multiple baggies in it.

An NCIC/FCIC check on Matheus showed that he did not have a valid driver license and that there was a seize tag order in place for his vehicle.

In order to safely investigate the alleged complaint, and in light of the witness statement that the subject was armed with a box cutter, the decision was made to handcuff Matheus. Officers moved towards him and he began to move backwards. He then started to run around the vehicle attempting to flee. A physical altercation then took place where Matheus was bracing, tensing, and pushing officers away in an attempt to avoid being handcuffed. Matheus was also not complying with officer's commands. Matheus ultimately had to be Tased in order for him to be handcuffed. Once secured, the box cutter was in fact found concealed on his person.

Contact was made with the building engineer, (RP) David Garmendia, who reiterated that Matheus had been in the parking garage since Saturday 01/13/2024 and refused to leave the private property when instructed to do so. Garmendia stated that when he told Matheus to leave, he started getting aggressive with him and moved his car to the third floor. When Garmendia noticed the box cutter, he stopped speaking with him out of concern for his safety

Matheus was transported to Cleveland Clinic by Sunrise Rescue 83 and was medically cleared.

Based on the facts and circumstances, the defendant was placed under arrest and transported to the Broward County Main Jail.

Under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the foregoing and that the facts stated therein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
