This was occurring even as Officer Baca was holding onto Hunter and attempting to get him away from the water. I then utilized by department issued conducted electrical weapons(TASER). The probes appeared to hit Hunter in his midsection at which point he was placed into handcuffs. Hunter was placed on his side and tended to by Sunrise Fire Rescue.</p>

I was dispatched as a back up to an Officer who was actively pursuing a black male. The black male later identified as Kadean Hunter had apparently stole merchandise from the Sawgrass Mall and took flight upon sight of law enforcement prior to this incident. Primary Officer Baca and I then observed Hunter concealing himself inside a fenced in area near the 12500 block of Sawgrass Mills Cir near the water. The structure was fully surrounded by a tall fence and could not be easily accessed by law enforcement. Hunter appeared to be moving about inside the fenced in area and looking for a way to escape law enforcement. Hunter was given multiple commands to exit and was advised he would be tasered multiple times. Hunter would continue to move about in a stealth like manner in what appeared to law enforcement that he was not going to comply. Hunter was eventually pulled down by law enforcement where he landed safely on the grass. Hunter then continued to actively resist by attempting to scoot into the water. This was occurring even as Officer Baca was holding onto Hunter and attempting to get him away from the water. I then utilized my department issued conducted electrical weapons (TASER). The probes appeared to hit Hunter in his midsection at which point he was placed into handcuffs. Hunter was placed on his side and tended to by Sunrise Fire Rescue.

On January 7th, 2024, at approximately 11:24 am, I was on foot patrol inside the Sawgrass Mills Mall when I saw a black male (later identified as Kadean Hunter). Kadean was wearing a light-colored sweat suit carrying a black tote full of clothes. I should note that I was on duty as a police officer wearing my class B uniform. When I first saw Kadean, he was inside Forever 21 and he appeared to be concealing the tote and hands in a display rack near the exit of store. When Kadean spotted me, he quickly slid behind a wall near the exit. Kadean then peaked to see if I was coming his way and upon seeing that I was, he then began to walk toward the second exit of the store. At this time, I suspected Kadean of shoplifting and hurried over to cut him off at the second exit of the store. Kadean saw me move to his destination and quickly changed course once again inside the store. Kadean then began running away from me and headed toward the rear of the store into the stock room. Kadean then exited the store through an open door in the stock room that lead to a parking lot where stores get deliveries. By the time I arrived at the parking lot I couldn't locate Kadean. I canvassed the immediate area where I last saw Kadean but was unable to locate him. At that moment it was unknown if Kadean had shoplifted items from Forever 21.

Approximately an hour later as I was driving through the mall parking lot, I saw Kadean getting into the passenger side of a vehicle. When I recognized Kadean as the same person who ran away from me earlier, I initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle. I turned the overhead lights on my patrol vehicle and activated the siren as well for the vehicle to stay put. The vehicle didn't move and then Kadean exited the passenger side and ran away from the traffic stop. Kadean ran southbound toward the Taco Bell restaurant on Blue Dolphin Blvd and Sawgrass Mills Circle and then turned right and headed westbound bordering the lake and the Nova Tires Shop at the 12500 block of Sawgrass Mills Circle. I was once again too far to catch up with Kadean and once again I had lost sight of him. I began to canvass the area behind the tire shop when a back-up officer spotted Kadean hiding inside a fenced-in area that houses a generator. The fence was approximately 8 feet tall and the gate was locked. Kadean jumped on top of the generator and began to pace east and west on in an attempt to jump where none of the officers were in order to continue his escape. Kadean placed his foot on top of the wobbly fence on the west-end of the containment and I grabbed it since he kept trying to evade us. Kadean then straddled the fence but continued his attempt to disengage from my grip. Eventually Kadean fell outward of the containment area and when he was on the ground, he continued his attempt to get lose from me to flee once again. I gave Kadean multiple commands to seize his escape efforts and to surrender peacefully. Kadean continued to struggle with us and was subsequently tased by Ofc. Mathers. Once tased, Kadean surrendered and was secured with hand restraints and placed under arrest for resisting a police officer.

Kadean was read his Miranda Rights via prepared text. Kadean advised he understood his rights and wished to answer our questions. I asked Kadean several questions involving this morning's incident at Forever 21, which Kadean [REDACTED]

Kadean sustained some small punctures on his inner right thigh from the straddling of the fence and also two punctures from the taser prongs on the right side of his body. Kadean was transported to Cleveland Clinic to be treated for his injuries and after being discharged he was transported to BSO main jail.



The black male later identified as Kadean Hunter had fled from Officer`s approximately 45 minutes prior after committing theft from the Sawgrass Mall. Officer Baca and I observed Hunter attempting to conceal himself inside a fenced in area near a body of water. The area was an electrical box fully surrounded by a tall chain fence and could not easily be accessed by Officer`s. Hunter appeared to be moving about inside the fenced in area and looking for a way to escape. Hunter was given multiple commands to exit and was advised he would be tasered. Hunter continued to disobey Officer`s commands and appeared that he was not going to comply. Hunter was eventually pulled down off the fence where he landed on the grass. Hunter then continued to actively resist arrest by attempting to enter the body of water. This was occurring as Officer Baca was on top of Hunter and holding him down and keeping him from entering the water. I told Hunter again he was going to get tasered if he did not stop resisting. Hunter was told to stop and get flat on the ground multiple times and he failed to comply. It should be noted that all Officer`s present were wearing police uniforms with a badge and agency insignia prominently displayed. I then utilized by department issued conducted electrical weapon (TASER). The probes appeared to hit Hunter in his midsection at which point he was placed into handcuffs. Hunter was escorted away from the water and placed on his side and tended to by Sunrise Fire Rescue. This was my involvement in this incident. A response to resistance report was completed as well as CEW use from. The spent Taser cartridge serial number X4921KY31 was placed into Sunrise Police evidence.

On January 7, 2024, I responded to 12575 W Sunrise Blvd, Sunrise, FL 33323 (Taco Bell) in reference to an individual who previously fled on foot from police. Prior to my arrival, Ofc. Baca (ID#3671) advised that the individual was a shoplifting suspect who fled from him inside of the mall.

Upon arrival, I witnessed Ofc. Mathers (ID#3665) and Ofc. Baca just west of the Taco Bell surrounding the subject. The subject had jumped over a fence and was standing on top of an electrical box enclosed within the fence. The subject refused to comply to officers' demands to jump over the fence. It should be noted that all officers were in full Class B Uniform with a Sunrise Insignia. I then went under the fence and helped the subject get over the fence due to his clothing getting stuck on the fence. While I was attempting go under the fence again, I heard Ofc. Mathers and Ofc. Baca demand the subject to stop resisting. I then heard a TASER deployment as I was getting up from the ground. I then rushed over to the subject on the ground and immediately detained the subject. Fire Rescue responded on scene and transported the subject to Cleveland Clinic. No further.

shouted several times at the defendant to stop running but defendant refused to do so and ran away from me after entering an employee only area in the back of the store and through a rear door that lead to the delivery area of the store. At the time, I was engaged in the lawful execution of my legal duties to investigate a suspected shoplifter. At the time, I was on-duty as a law enforcement officer for the City of Sunrise. I was in full uniform with visible police markings on my vest and both shirt sleeves. At the time, the defendant knew I was a police officer, as per his statement after being advised of his Miranda rights.

While patrolling the mall approximately 50 minutes later, I saw the defendant getting into a burgundy vehicle near the intersection of Sawgrass Mills Circle and Blue Dolphin Blvd. This time I was in my patrol vehicle that is striped appropriately with all police markings and with an overhead light bar. Upon identifying the defendant, I initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle by activating the overhead lights on my vehicle and also my siren. At this time, the defendant exited the passenger side of the vehicle and ran away from the traffic stop. The defendant ran southbound toward the drive-thru of the Taco Bell restaurant. I chased after the defendant with lights and sirens activated to the drive-thru of the Taco Bell, the defendant then turned right and ran westbound bordering the lake and behind the Nova Tire Shop building. I drove and parked my squad car to the rear of the tire shop and exited my vehicle to look for the defendant since I had lost sight of him again. Defendant was then found concealing inside a fenced area that houses a generator by arriving units to assist me in the search. Defendant was instructed to exit the fenced area and give himself up to us, but still refused to do so. The defendant then placed his foot on top of the fence and grabbed a hold of it and brought the defendant down. Once the defendant was on the ground he refused to be placed in hand restraints and was subsequently tased. We were then able to restraint the defendant and placed him under arrest for resisting an officer without violence.

The defendant was read his Miranda rights which he understood and waived, and then stated [REDACTED]

I should also note that [REDACTED] the stolen property from Forever 21 store which the retail price amounted to \$261.19. The store supervisor did not wish to press charges at this time.

The defendant was transported to Cleveland Clinic for medical clearance and after being discharged, the defendant was transported to BSO main jail.
