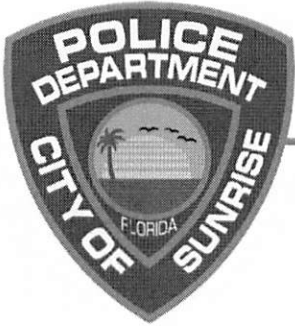




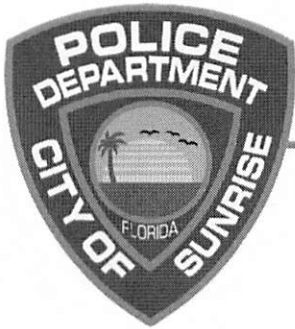

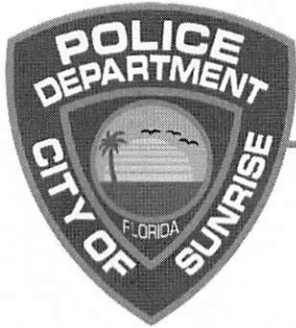

<p>Prior to going on duty for a detail, I heard K9-51 Officer Plunske on the radio requesting assistance from officers as he was in a physical altercation with two theft suspects. The second suspect, a black male wearing all blue, had proceeded to flee the area while struggling to detain the two subjects alone. I then observed a black male as I entered the Colonnades through the east entrance matching the description as described by Ofc. Plunski attempting to conceal himself behind a pillar. I proceeded to have Ofc. Martinez attempted to cut off the subject to prevent him from fleeing further west through the Colonnades as I approached from the east. As the subject observed Ofc. Martinez drive past him, he proceeds to double back, running toward my direction. The subject was observed to be holding a black object in his hands, at which point I drew my Taser and gave him verbal commands to stop running, or he would be tased.</p>

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Narrative - continued

The subject refused to comply and proceeded to continue to run, at which point I deployed my Taser. On the first cartridge deployed, one prong made contact with the defendant's upper back while the other prong missed, rendering it ineffective. The second deployment was taken where one prong made contact with the suspect's lower back, causing the Taser to become effective. The subject fell to the ground but then removed the prongs from his back before a second arch could be applied. The subject then proceeds to get back up and run before being apprehended shortly after.

The suspect was transported to Cleveland Clinic by Sunrise Fire rescue 48, and later transported to the Broward County Main jail on several felony charges.

It is to be noted that during the incident, I was wearing my Class B department uniform with clear police insignia and badging.

On Friday, January 12, 2024, the defendant, Desmand Deshaund Lyles, did, knowing and intentionally, disobey lawful commands to stop running and took flight upon officers attempting to make contact with him while officers attempted to conduct a lawful shoplifting investigation, in accordance with Florida State Statue 843.01.

Prior to going on duty for a detail, I heard K9-51 Officer Plunске on the radio requesting assistance from officers as he was in a physical altercation with two theft suspects. The second suspect, a black male wearing all blue, had proceeded to flee the area while struggling to detain the two subjects alone. Ofc. Plunске stated the black male was last seen running towards the Old Bed Bath and Beyond building towards the Colonnades shops. I then observed the male as I entered the colonnades through the east entrance. I observed the subject as described by Ofc. Plunски, attempting to conceal himself behind a pillar, I proceeded to have Ofc. Martinez attempted to cut off the subject to prevent him from fleeing further west through the colonnades as I approached from the east. As the subject observed Ofc. Martinez drive past him, he proceeds to double back, running toward my direction. The subject was observed to be holding a black object in his hands, at which point I drew my Taser and gave him verbal commands to stop running, or he would be tased.

The subject refused to comply and proceeded to continue to run, at which point I deployed my Taser. The first cartridge deployed, one prong made contact with the defendant's upper back while the other prong missed, rendering it ineffective. On the second deployment, one prong made contact with the suspect's lower back, causing the Taser to become effective. The subject fell to the ground but then removed the prongs from his back before a second arch could be applied. The subject then proceeds to get back up and run before being apprehended shortly after.

After identifying the subject, it was discovered that the subject, though matching the description provided by Officer Plunски, was not the actual suspect who had ran from Officer Plunски. It was discovered that the suspect had just committed a theft at Coach Outlet and saw officers in the area, fearing Officers were coming to detain him. The suspect proceeded to drop the stolen items and attempted to conceal himself behind a pillar before finally taking flight upon contact with me. Further investigation revealed that the suspect is known to shoplift at the Sawgrass Mills Mall several times in the past and most recently was positively identified for a theft at Gucci Outlet, which I investigated, Sunrise Police Case 42-2311-054125. It is to be noted that the defendant is currently on felony probation for dealing in stolen property and is in direct violation of his conditions with this arrest.

Post Miranda, the defendant [REDACTED] Several items from Coach Outlet were located where the suspect had dropped the items before taking flight. A follow-up was conducted with Coach Outlet by Officer C. Leon, where CCTV footage depicted the suspect concealing the items and walking past all points of sale. It is to be noted Coach Outlet does wish to prosecute.

The defendant was transported to Cleveland Clinic and later transported to the Broward County Main Jail without incident.

Under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the foregoing and that the facts stated therein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. Body Worn camera was used during this investigation.

On 01/12/2024, Sunrise Police Officers responded to 12801 W Sunrise Blvd (Sawgrass Mills Mall) in reference to an in-progress shoplifting at H&M. Upon officer`s arrival in the area, they observed a black male, later identified as Desmand Lyles (OF), running along Sawgrass Mills Circle, attempting to avoid police contact. Desmand was later apprehended at the intersection of Purple Parrot Place and Sawgrass Mills Circle pending further investigation. It should be noted that Desmand was found to have a red perfume box from COACH on his person. See original affidavit for previous charges.

The following day I conducted a follow-up investigation into the theft that occurred at COACH. I met with Loss Prevention Agent Gelsey who stated that he observed the Desmand along with two other females via floor surveillance selecting and concealing merchandise. Desmand was viewed selecting a red box of perfume with the word "love" written on it, from the shelf. Desmand was then observed concealing the item in his right-side pocket and then exited the store, passing all points of sale, making no attempt to pay for the selected and concealed merchandise, temporarily or permanently depriving COACH of its property. The box of perfume was found to be valued at \$72.00. Upon further investigation, it was discovered the two other females that were present, walked out with 8 other items of clothing, valued at \$1,054.00 bringing the total loss to \$1,126.00.

One female was described as a black female, wearing a black head rag, a leopard print dress, and a black jacket. The second female was described as a black female wearing a light denim colored jacket and pants with a light-colored top.

Loss Prevention Agent Gelsey provided a video of the theft occurring and desired prosecution for the entire incident. The itemized receipt of all the items taken and CCTV footage were uploaded to evidence.com.

It should be noted that a criminal history check of Desmand revealed two previous convictions for theft. He was also previously trespassed from the Sawgrass Mills Mall indefinitely in 2017 by Detective Coronado. Reference 42-1712-070809.

Desmand was ultimately charged for the aforementioned charges. The Probable Cause affidavit was generated for this incident and dropped off at BSO Main Jail where Desmand was being held on the previous charges.

This case is CLEARED BY ARREST.


