- a. The Sustainability Officer noted that World Health Day was April 5, 2024, and the City was coordinating an event at the Civic Center. The Good and Green booth would be participating at this event.
- b. The Earth Day Festival was scheduled for April 6, 2024, at Sawgrass Sanctuary Park.

- g. The Sustainability Officer announced that the home of two City employees (who live in Dania Beach) won an Emerald Award at the 2024 Broward County Water Matters Day event.
