IA-23-09-01 – Complaint Letter

Internal investigation did not find evidence to support the complainant's allegations against officer. Board members concur letter was vindictive and sent with the purpose to tarnish Officer's reputation.

IA-23-09-01

Internal investigation did not find evidence to support the complainant's allegations against officer.

IA-23-09-02

Investigation revealed numerous officers were not entering time correctly or not at all into KRONOS. Additional training for officers was suggested. The officers were found responsible for the errors and the time was debited back from officers.
