As Ofc Hennessy walked the DEF toward the front doors, the DEF began pulling away as if to break free from his grasp. I helped direct the DEF out of the front doors as the DEF continued to pull away from us. Once we exited the front doors, the DEF turned and squared up with me as we tried to direct him towards our vehicles. As the DEF squared up with me, it appeared he was about to spit in my face so I punched him in the face twice to redirect his face then escorted him to the side of Ofc Hennessy's vehicle before he was placed in the backseat without further incident.</p>

Location: Crafty Crab located at 2019 N University Drive

On the specified date and time, I was dispatched to Crafty Crab located at 2019 N University Drive in response to a disturbance involving a Hispanic male, subsequently identified as Frank Ernesto Panameno Cuadra. The initial report described the individual as wearing a blue shirt and blue jeans, engaging in indecent exposure towards women in the parking area. Further updates indicated Mr. Panameno Cuadra's proximity to a white Toyota Corolla, where he appeared to have inadvertently locked his keys inside. Additional information suggested that Mr. Panameno Cuadra was armed with a firearm.

Upon arrival at the scene, I observed an individual matching Mr. Panameno Cuadra's description. He was navigating around the vehicle and retreated into the restaurant upon noticing law enforcement presence. The establishment's hostess directed me to Mr. Panameno Cuadra as he moved towards the restroom. I maintained surveillance of the area while awaiting additional officers. [REDACTED] the reporting party, approached me alleging that Mr. Panameno Cuadra had exposed himself to her and another woman in the parking lot. The hostess corroborated this account, adding that a colleague had witnessed Mr. Panameno Cuadra brandishing a firearm near the aforementioned vehicle.

Subsequently, Mr. Panameno Cuadra exited the restroom and headed towards the exit, where I discreetly positioned myself. Based on the provided descriptions, I initiated an encounter with Mr. Panameno Cuadra, instructing him to place his hands behind his back and informing him that he was being detained. He initially complied but quickly began to resist by actively bracing, tensing and pulling from Officer D. Troccoli and I.

During a check of his person for weapons, I discovered a .380 caliber firearm magazine in Mr. Panameno Cuadra's right jean pocket which contained eight rounds, although the firearm itself was not found on his person. A subsequent search by Officer P. Hormann yielded the firearm, concealed within a brown paper bag under the rear bumper of the Corolla. It was identified as a Smith & Wesson M&P Shield, chambered in .380 caliber, loaded one round in the chamber and six round inside the second magazine inside the firearm.

In dialogue with Laur`N Six Miller, Mr. Panameno Cuadra's girlfriend, she acknowledged his ownership of a firearm but denied witnessing any indecent or threatening behavior. Despite her claims of ignorance regarding the firearm's presence, discrepancies arose as Mr. Panameno Cuadra stated he had entrusted the bag containing the firearm to Ms. Miller.

Further testimony was provided by [REDACTED] who detailed encountering Mr. Panameno Cuadra's inappropriate conduct firsthand. She recounted instances of him exposing himself and engaging in lewd behavior. In her statement [REDACTED] told me that on two separate instances Mr. Panameno Cuadra pulled down his pants and underwear at which time he made thrusting motions and shook his penis around while staring at her. [REDACTED] account was corroborated by a sworn affidavit, which has been formally submitted as evidence.

[REDACTED] another witness, affirmed [REDACTED] allegations regarding Mr. Panameno Cuadra's conduct, though she refrained from providing a written statement at the time.

Following his rights being read, Mr. Panameno Cuadra [REDACTED] He denied the allegations of indecent exposure. His behavior during the interview was notably erratic, and he exhibited signs of alcohol intoxication. There was a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating

from his breath as he spoke to me.

Based on the statements taken from [REDACTED] it does not appear that any juveniles witnessed his unlawful display of his sexual organ. However, his actions did corrupt the public morals and outraged the sense of public decency. Furthermore, while being lawfully detained he did actively brace, tense and pull from officers. As such, the investigation concluded that Mr. Panameno Cuadra's actions constituted a disorderly conduct and an act of resisting arrest without violence, leading to charges under Florida State Statutes 877.03 and 843.02, respectively, for breach of peace, disorderly conduct, and resisting an officer without violence.

Officer P. Hormann secured the firearm in evidence for safekeeping. A database check on the firearm returned no concerns. All pertinent documentation and evidence, including [REDACTED] sworn affidavit, have been processed accordingly. Mr. Panameno Cuadra's personal belongings were released to his parents, upon his request, at the scene. The entirety of the incident was documented via body-worn camera. Mr. Panameno Cuadra was subsequently arrested and transported to the Broward County Main Jail for processing. The situation was resolved without further disturbances.

Under penalties of perjury I declare that I have read the foregoing and that the facts stated therein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

I responded to the Crafty Crab (2019 North University Drive) reference to a report of a male exposing himself and displaying a firearm. Upon arrival, Sunrise Officer Hennessy was already in contact with the male in question, Frank Ernesto Panameno Cuadra (H/M, 02-21-01), inside the restaurant. Upon checking Frank's person, Sunrise Officers located a pistol magazine (M&P metal with black base magazine) on his person containing eight .380 bullets. It was advised by those inside the restaurant that Frank was seen in the parking lot with a pistol in his hand and came into the restaurant, entering the men's bathroom. A check of the men's bathroom was conducted but I was unable to locate a pistol.

Sunrise Officers were able to locate Frank's vehicle in the Crafty Crab's parking lot, a white 2011 Toyota Corolla with attached Florida tag 01BBTW. Standing outside of the vehicle was a black female, Laur'n Six Miller (B/F, 02-28-03) who identified herself as Frank's girlfriend. While standing on the driver side of the vehicle, I noticed a brown Crafty Crab bag on the curb by the rear bumper of the vehicle. When asked what this bag was, Laur'n stated it was their bag with their leftovers. Seeing that the bag was large enough to conceal a pistol, I checked the bag at which time I found a Smith & Wesson M&P 380 Shield inside of it. The M&P was upside down in the bag, under the couple's bagged up leftovers.

The listed Smith & Wesson M&P 380 Shield with serial number REZ7701 was removed from the brown Crafty Crab bag and made safe. The M&P had on metal and black magazine inserted in it (same as the one found on Frank's person) with six .380 bullets in it and one .380 bullet in the chamber. An NCIC/FCIC check was conducted for the Smith & Wesson M&P 380 Shield with serial number REZ7701 but came back with negative results.

The Smith & Wesson M&P 380 Shield with serial number REZ7701, the two magazines, the .380 ammunition, as well as the brown Crafty Crab bag it was found in were collected and entered into Evidence for safe-keeping at our Public Safety Building (locker 16).

Once we exited the front doors, the DEF turned and squared up with me as we tried to direct him toward our vehicles. As the DEF squared up with me, it appeared he was about to spit in my face so I punched him in the face twice to redirect his face then escorted him to the side of Ofc Hennessy's vehicle before he was placed in the backseat without further incident.

After assisting Ofc Hennessy I completed a Response to Resistance Report which was turned in to Sgt. Negron.

I had no further involvement in this case.
