<u>Brazilian Voices</u>- Guest speakers, Viviane Neves and Loren Oliveira from the award-winning South Florida female vocal ensemble gave an overview of their upcoming theatre performance. Their "Jazz Across Cultures" concert demonstrates the connection between American jazz and its Brazilian cousin, bossa nova. The Girl Choir of South Florida will be special guests joining the performance. Ms. Neves shared that they were named the 2022 Non-Profit Organization of the Year for their performances at hospitals and assisted living facilities. They created a virtual performance for people with Autism during COVID and recently performed the Quiet Bossa-Jazz for All, an interactive performance piece designed to inform and entertain, with the accompaniment of the audience using soft percussion instruments.
