

Storm Season is Underway: Stay Informed, Sunrise!

Peak hurricane season in Florida—the period from mid-August to mid-October—is upon us. During this time, it's especially important to stay connected to reliable sources of information. These communication tools will enable you to receive updates from the City of Sunrise:

The City uses the high speed **CodeRED** notification system to alert residents in the event of a boil water order, storm, or other emergency. The only way to be sure you're in our phone number database is to register. It's simple to do online, and takes only minutes. Visit sunrisefl.gov/codered to sign up online, or text AlertSunrise to 99411.

RESIDENTIAL FENCE REPAIR INCENTIVE PROGRAM

DO YOU NEED HELP WITH THE COST OF FENCE REPAIRS?

The Sunrise City Commission has allocated federal funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for a Residential Fence Repair Incentive Program. This Program is intended to provide homeowners with a financial reimbursement incentive of up to \$500 for fence repairs made to their homesteaded residential property in Sunrise.

Eligible homeowners may apply to receive up to a **\$500 REIMBURSEMENT** after making repairs or improvements to an existing residential fence, such as:

- Replacing fence slats, posts and other parts of the fence structure
- Painting or staining the fence
- Installing or repairing fence hardware
