

Storm Season is Underway: Stay Informed, Sunrise!

Peak hurricane season in Florida—the period from mid-August to mid-October—is upon us. During this time, it's especially important to stay connected to reliable sources of information. These communication tools will enable you to receive updates from the City of Sunrise:

The City uses the high speed **CodeRED** notification system to alert residents in the event of a boil water order, storm, or other emergency. The only way to be sure you're in our phone number database is to register. It's simple to do online, and takes only minutes. Visit sunrisefl.gov/codered to sign up online, or text AlertSunrise to 99411.

The **Sunrise Source** is the City's weekly email newsletter. Each Source features information about upcoming events and activities – as well as important news. Visit sunrisefl.gov/sunrisesource to opt in!
