Dave'On ultimately parked in the driveway of 9050 NW 35th PL, opened the door of his vehicle and stepped out. I instructed Dave'On to step back inside of his vehicle, to which he refused, becoming verbally combative telling me that I could not pull him over in front of his residence. Due to Dave'On demeanor officers approached his vehicle in attempts to de-escalate the situation and proceed with the traffic stop. However, Dave'On continued to be verbally combative with officers refusing all commands. Dave'On then re-entered his vehicle and began honking to beckon for individuals within the residence to come outside. For the safety of all parties on scene, officers instructed Dave'On to stop honking his horn and ordered him to step back out of the vehicle, to which he refused.</p>

Narrative - continued

Due to Dave'Ons refusal to comply with the orders given by officers, officers established positive contact with both of his arms and physically removed him from the vehicle, escorting him to the ground.

While officers were attempting to place Dave'On in hand-cuffs, he continued to physically resist, digging his hands and stiffening his body to prevent his detention. I then gave Dave'On multiple warnings to comply, advising that if he did not, he would be tased, which he refused. As a result, I deployed my Sunrise Police Department issued Axon Taser, establishing positive contact with the top right side of Dave'On shoulder. Dave'On continued to resist officers' commands, oscillating and tensing his body in a manner which prevented officers from placing him in hand-cuffs, which in turn resulted into a secondary deployment of my taser. Officers ultimately gained Dave'On compliance, placing him in hand-cuffs.

On 03/23/2024 at approximately 2214hrs, while on duly appointed patrol, as a sworn law enforcement officer in the State of Florida, County of Broward, City of Sunrise, I observed a white Toyota Avalon turning northbound on the 9000 block of W. Oakland Park Blvd with its headlights turned off.

The vehicle proceeded to drive northbound on NW 90th Ter. To then make a turn facing westbound on the 35th PL, which is when I activated my police lights to indicate the beginning of my lawful stop. It should be noted that at the time of my stop, I was driving an authorized marked City of Sunrise Police Department law enforcement patrol vehicle, with agency insignia and other jurisdictional markings prominently displayed on the vehicle, with lights and audible sirens activated. The driver, later identified as Dave`On Lawrence, ultimately parked at 9050 NW 35th PL, opened the door of his vehicle and stepped out. I instructed the driver of the vehicle to step back inside his vehicle, to which he refused, becoming verbally combative telling me that I could not pull him over in front of his residence. Due to the defendant`s demeanor officers approached his vehicle in attempts to de-escalate the situation and proceed with the traffic stop. However, Dave`On continued to be verbally combative with officers disputing all instructions. Dave`On then re-entered his vehicle and began honking his audible vehicle horn while beckoning for individuals within the residence to come outside. For the safety of all parties on scene, officers instructed Dave`On to stop honking his horn and ordered him to step back out of the vehicle, to which he refused. Due to Dave`On`s refusal to comply with the orders given by officers, officers established positive contact with both of Dave`On`s arms and physically removed him from the vehicle, escorting him to the ground.

While officers were attempting to place Dave`On in handcuffs, he continued to physically resist, digging his hands under his body and stiffening his body to prevent detention. I then gave Dave`On multiple warnings to comply, advising that if he did not, he would be tased, but to no avail. As a result, I deployed my Sunrise Police Department-issued Axon Taser, establishing positive contact with the top right side of Dave`On`s shoulder. Dave`On continued to resist officers` commands, which in turn resulted in a secondary deployment of my taser. Officers ultimately gained Dave`On`s compliance, placing him in handcuffs.

A police database search also revealed Dave`On has a suspended Florida Driver`s License. A search for wants/warrants yielded negative results.

Due to Dave`On being tased he was transported to Florida Medical Center by Sunrise Fire Rescue #59, where he was medically cleared by hospital staff.

I then advised Dave`On of his Miranda Warnings via department-prepared text, which he freely waived by establishing a conversation with myself. Dave`On [REDACTED]

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
It should be noted that from the time of arrest to the time of receiving clearance from the hospital, Dave`On continued to remain uncompliant with officers, tensing, bracing, pushing, and pulling from officers` control and ignoring all provided instructions.

Dave`On`s vehicle was left in the possession of his mother and parked in the driveway of his residence, which is the address where the incident took place.

I then completed a Response to Resistance and Conducted Energy Weapon Report, which was submitted to Sgt. Maristany for approval. The cartridges deployed were submitted into Sunrise Police Evidence Locker #16. Pictures of the probe contact on Dave`On`s body were submitted by officers to Axon Evidence.

Dave`On was then transported to Broward County Main Jail where he was left in the care/custody of the Broward Sheriff`s Office without further incident.

On 03/23/2024, I responded to the above-listed location as a backup officer on a traffic stop.

Upon arrival, I observed the driver (later identified as Dave`on Lawrence) sitting with both legs hanging out of the vehicle with the driver`s door open. As officers approached the vehicle, the driver stated that he had just gotten home from work. The driver was then given commands to get back into the vehicle which he ignored and he began to utilize his vehicle horn as a means of getting the attention of individuals within his residence.

To ensure the safety of all involved parties and to prevent unknown individuals from interfering with a police investigation, the driver was asked to step out of the vehicle. After a refusal, officers made positive contact with the driver`s arms to escort him out of the vehicle to which he became combative and began to stiffen his body to restrict officers from gaining control of his arms. At this moment, I attempted to place the driver in handcuffs to which he continued to resist by stiffening and bringing his arms close to his body while balling his fist up as a means to prevent the handcuffs from being placed on his wrists. The driver was given several commands to stop resisting but he continued to pull away as I was attempting to secure the handcuffs. In an effort to gain compliance and safely detain the subject as he was resisting, Ofc [REDACTED] deployed his department-issued Axon taser which made contact with the upper right portion of the driver`s back. Following the deployment, the driver began to kick at officers while flailing his arm which resulted in a second taser deployment by Officer [REDACTED]. The second deployment was successful and officers were able to get the driver on his stomach after which handcuffs were placed on his wrists allowing officers to safely take the driver into custody.

Due to the driver being stuck by the prongs of the taser, Sunrise Fire Rescue responded to the scene to render medical aid. It was determined that the subject would need to be medically cleared in which he was transported by the rescue unit to Florida Medical Center where he was treated and discharged. Upon completion of the required documentation, Ofc [REDACTED] transported the subject to the Broward County Main Jail where he was left in the custody of their staff.
