<p>At approximately 1333 hours on 04/03/2024, Officers responded to the Target store and were told that Loss Prevention was watching a black male wearing a bucket hat, short sleeve button down shirt, and long pants select and conceal merchandise inside the bags that were taken from the store shelf. Officers waited outside the store and a male matching the suspect description exited the store. Loss Prevention attempted to apprehend the subject but he evaded them. Loss Prevention then pointed to the subject stating he was the shoplifter. Officers told the male to stop and come back. The subject then took flight into the parking lot, thus actively resisting our lawful effort to detain him.</p> <p>Once I caught up to the suspect, I unholstered my taser and told the male to get on the ground or else I would tase him. He refused to comply therefore I deployed one taser cartridge which was ineffective. I then immediately deployed a second cartridge which was also ineffective.</p>

Officers had to assist the suspect to the ground where he continued to resist by pulling, bracing, and tensing his arms until officers were able to place handcuff restraints on him. It should be noted that at no time did the suspect comply while being detained. It should be noted that all Officers who had confronted Brown were wearing a Class B uniform. These uniforms displayed departmental insignia and police badges.

Brown was treated on scene by Sunrise Fire Rescue #92. He was then transported to Cleveland Clinic Medical Center. Brown was medically cleared for the jail and later transported to BSO main jail for processing. At no point did Brown advise he was injured or experiencing any medical issues from the Taser contact. Throughout the investigation, Brown was very uncooperative with police, fire rescue and medical staff. He was later identified at BSO Main Jail as he refused to identify himself earlier in the investigation.

At the conclusion of the investigation, Brown was charged with two counts of resisting law enforcement without violence, one count of grand theft, and one count of violation of felony probation.

My BWC was active during the events that transpired.

Subject's Behavior

This incident was captured on my department issued Body-Worn Camera.

Officers responded to Target in reference to a shoplifting in-progress. Upon arrival, the Loss Prevention Agent pointed the subject out as he was exiting the store. Officers gave loud verbal commands to the suspect to come back however the suspect did not comply. The suspect actively resisted law enforcement and fled on foot from Officers. I caught up to the subject and told him to get on the floor with his hands behind his back or else I would tase him. The subject did not comply therefore I deployed two taser cartridges at the subject. The subject did not react to the taser strikes. He was eventually detained in handcuffs by myself, [Redacted] and [Redacted]. While receiving medical clearance, two minor marks from the taser prongs were located on the suspect's left arm. No other marks were located.

The subject was ultimately arrested for 2 felonies and 1 misdemeanor.

On 04/03/2024 I responded to the Target located at 12801 W Sunrise Boulevard, located in the jurisdictional limits of the City of Sunrise, County of Broward, State of Florida regarding a shoplifter. Target Loss Prevention Specialist Amanda Beller (RP) called in and stated that they were on-viewing a medium-built black male with a bucket hat, actively concealing merchandise throughout the entire store. Before my arrival, Amanda advised that the subject had left the store and was currently walking on the exterior.

As I arrived on the scene, Amanda pointed to the black male outside and stated that he was the one they viewed concealing the merchandise. I identified myself as a Sunrise Police Officer and lawfully commanded the male to stop and come talk to me. The male, later identified as Nolan Brown (OF) looked back and immediately took flight, in an attempt to avoid contact. I pursued Nolan through the Target parking lot, around the side of the store, and into the mall parking lot. Myself, along with other Sunrise Police Officers caught up to him who immediately took an aggressive, fighting stance, while yelling "They got their shit back, stop harassing me". Nolan was given ample amounts of time and commands to get on the ground however he continuously resisted. [REDACTED] deployed his department-issued Taser to gain compliance however Nolan ripped out the Taser prongs and continued to resist. More Sunrise police officers responded and assisted in bringing Nolan to the ground. It should be noted that Nolan continued to resist by bracing his arms against his body, attempting to defeat being placed in handcuffs. After several attempts, he was successfully placed in secure custody.

Contact was reestablished with Amanda who stated that Nolan concealed merchandise in the store using several backpacks that he took off a store shelf. It wasn't until he passed all points of sale, exiting Target's main doors, that he made contact with Loss Prevention, dropping backpacks full of merchandise. Amanda desired prosecution on behalf of Target (VI) for being temporarily deprived of their merchandise. An itemized receipt for the totaled merchandise concealed was provided which amounted to \$1,084.54.

Nolan was placed under arrest for Grand Theft, Resisting Without Violence, and Violation of Probation. He was subsequently transported to BSO Main Jail for processing. It should be noted that Nolan refused to identify himself throughout the process, not choosing to speak. It wasn't until we arrived at BSO Main Jail that he decided to give me his full name and date of birth. An FCIC/NCIC check revealed that Nolan was on probation for Burglary.

Amanda signed an affidavit accordingly on behalf of Target confirming prosecution. A Shoplifter Apprehension Form was also completed. A Sworn Taped statement was taken by Amanda on Body Worn Camera and uploaded to evidence.com. The signed affidavit, the completed Shoplifter Apprehension Form, and the itemized receipt were all submitted to Sunrise Records. A link to evidence.com was sent to Amanda to upload videos/ pictures pertaining to the incident. She was also provided a Sunrise case number for documentation.

Reference this case, Nolan was indefinitely trespassed from the Sawgrass Mills Mall which is an active member of the Sunrise Trespass Program with signage posted. Nolan advised he understood the trespass warning. An FI Card was completed.


