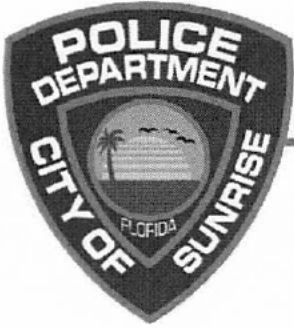

[REDACTED] disregarded my commands, and continued toward NW 136th Avenue on Azure Alley.

Upon making contact with [REDACTED] he continued to refuse lawful commands to get on the ground, and braced and tensed his body in an attempt to resist my efforts to detain him. Using a straight arm bar takedown, I escorted [REDACTED] to the ground. While being escorted to the ground, [REDACTED] grazed a nearby palm tree, but did not appear to sustain any injury.

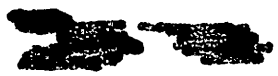

On 06/15/2024, at approximately 21:48 hours, Sunrise Police Officers were dispatched to the Target department store parking lot, located at the Sawgrass Mills Mall, 12801 West Sunrise Boulevard, in the City of Sunrise, County of Broward, State of Florida, in reference to a group of juveniles lighting off fireworks on mall property.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Sawgrass Mills Mall Security personnel, who identified the group of juveniles they observed lighting fireworks on mall property. At the request of mall security, I trespassed the group of five juveniles (one black female, four black males) from the entirety of mall property, and instructed them to immediately vacate the premises.

Rather than immediately vacating the premises, the juveniles paused multiple times to light off more fireworks. I then provided the juveniles' location over the radio, for additional responding officers to again make contact with the group. Shortly thereafter, Sunrise Police Sergeant [REDACTED] advised over the radio that the juveniles were still lighting fireworks on property, and running away from him.

With the overhead emergency lights and siren of my marked City of Sunrise police vehicle activated, I attempted to stop one of the juveniles, [REDACTED] (OF), as he was fleeing on foot on Azure Alley toward NW 136th Avenue (still on mall property). I then pulled ahead of [REDACTED] exited my vehicle, and in full road patrol uniform with badge and insignia affixed, ordered [REDACTED] to get on the ground. [REDACTED] disregarded my commands, and continued toward NW 136th Avenue on Azure Alley.

Upon making contact with [REDACTED] he continued to refuse lawful commands to get on the ground, and braced and tensed his body in an attempt to resist my efforts to detain him. Using a straight arm bar takedown, I escorted [REDACTED] to the ground. While being escorted to the ground, [REDACTED] grazed a nearby palm tree, but did not appear to sustain injury.

While I was taking [REDACTED] into custody, Sunrise Police Officer [REDACTED] was arresting one of the other juveniles, [REDACTED] (IO). [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were transported to the Sunrise Police Department sallyport by Officer [REDACTED] and myself, for completion of the probable cause affidavits. While at the PD, [REDACTED] father, HOWARD WYNTER (IO), was notified of his son's arrest. Officer [REDACTED] then transported [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to the Broward County Juvenile Assessment Center (JAC).

Once at the JAC, [REDACTED] stated to JAC intake personnel that his neck was sore due to striking his head on a tree while being taken into custody, requiring that he receive medical clearance. Officer [REDACTED] then transported [REDACTED] to Broward Health Medical Center, where he was administered an over the counter pain reliever, and had a splinter removed from his hand by medical staff. [REDACTED] was subsequently cleared for booking, and transported back to the JAC by Officer [REDACTED]

Due to [REDACTED] claiming an in-custody injury, on 06/16/2024, I completed a Response to Resistance Report and submitted it to Sergeant [REDACTED]
