**Card Board** : corrugated cardboard, cereal cartons, etc



**Plastic Containers** : soda/water bottles, milk, juice, detergent & shampoo bottles/containers, etc.

**Automotive Waste** (no coolants or gas) : car batteries & oil-based fluids: motor oil, steering, & transmission
